The criteria for evaluating applications will be in accordance with the Erasmus Exchange Program Regulation of Haliç University.

A. Evaluation Criteria for Academic Staff Benefiting from the Erasmus+ Teaching Mobility Program

NO	CRITERIA	POINTS
1.	Being a first-time beneficiary of the Erasmus+ Staff Mobility Program	15
2.	Being the Erasmus Department Coordinator (The appointment letter must be before 18.11.2024. Staff who do not upload the appointment letter to the application portal will not receive additional points.)	10
3.	Foreign language score*	+20%
4.	Having an Erasmus Agreement	10
5.	Years of service:	1-5 years 6-10 years 11+ years
6.	Going to a department that has not been visited before	10
7.	If the person has previously participated in a mobility activity:	1 time 2 times 3 times or more
8.	Not participating in mobility without a valid reason	-10

Note: In case of a tie in points, priority will be determined in the following order: 1, 4, 7, 6, 5, 3.

Academic Staff Evaluation Criteria

Criteria	Weighted Points
Activities related to Artificial Intelligence (AI), prioritized within the 2021-2025 National AI Strategy prepared by the Presidency of the Digital Transformation Office.	+5
Priority will be given to staff with disabilities.	+10
Priority will be given to staff who are veterans, or the spouses and children of martyrs and veterans (Valid for only Republic of Türkiye citizens)	+10
Priority is given to those who or their first degree relatives receive disaster victim aid from AFAD.	+10
Mobility to the country of citizenship will be given lower priority.	-10

Note: The activities related to Artificial Intelligence, as outlined in the 2021-2025 National AI Strategy by the Presidency of the Digital Transformation Office, must be detailed in the Mobility Agreement document.
